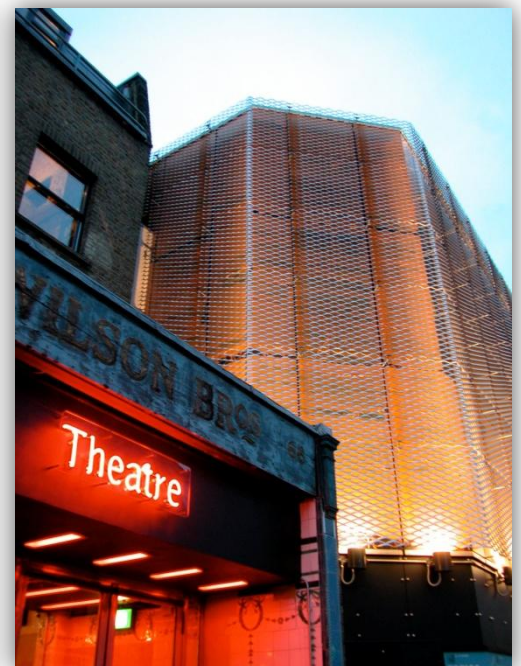

The Young Vic Theatre was redeveloped over the course of an 18-month contract from 2005. The building was eventually nominated for the Sterling Prize in 2007. Capri worked closely with consulting engineers Max Fordham and theatre consultants Charcoalblue, and hand-in hand with specialist contractor Northern Light to install hugely flexible performance systems (lighting, lighting control, sound and communications, paging and show relay). Capri were responsible for the development and installation of all containment, ETC Sensor dimmers (all fully patched), production lighting wiring, sound and communications wiring, and an extensive array of facilities panels to the main auditorium, and two smaller studios.
